3.1	<i>4.6.1 Fencing (page 20) – will a timber post and rail corrugated iron fence suffice as solid fencing?</i>	Yes. The steel is to be in a reasonable condition and have no sharp edges etc.
3.2	<i>The schedules in the carpentry sections, Internal Timber Partitions, have the units marked as m2. Is this correct, and if so, is there a formula we can use to convert m2 to LM?</i>	Respondents to make their own judgement as to the quantities from the drawings and schedules for this item.
3.3	<i>Desk top cabling – what is the design proposal for the horizontal segregated duct at desk locations (drawing E09)?</i>	The power and data is to be taken from the cable trays and at one location per desk set taken down a proprietary 'dropper'. Junction boxes for power and data are to be fixed to the cable tray. The desks are to be have ducting through/under them to allow for the power and data. Power boxes to be supplied with desks at each work station.
3.4	<i>4.24 As-built Drawings (page 24-25) - will the successful Contractor have access to a full set of CAD drawings for 'as-built' purposes?</i>	Yes, .dwg base drawings will be provided for as-builts.
3.5	<i>Generator installation in the Admin & Library building - the schedule of quantities states that there is a 125 KVA generator as specified but on drawing E13 it states future generator set by others, please clarify whether bidder should allow for the generator or not?</i>	Respondents are to disregard the Generator Installation section in the Schedule of Quantities (Admin & Library- page 19/3, items A and C). The generator and associated cabling has been removed from the Contract Works.
3.6	<i>Technology block drawing T9.01, window Type 04 and 05, and</i>	Respondents are to disregard the reference to <i>mechanical fixed louvre to top</i> . There are no louvres required for Type 04

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	<i>Schedule of Quantities (Technology) page 10/3, items K and L.</i>	and 05 windows. Respondent to cost based on the design in drawing T9.01.
3.7	<i>Attachment 1 (Scope of Work and Specific Requirements), section 3.3 – paragraph 3. Is the Contractor of Stage 1 or the Contractor for civil works responsible for the connection costs?</i>	Respondents shall allow for the connection costs as reflected in the Schedule of Quantities.
3.8	<i>Attachment 1 (Scope of Work and Specific Requirements), section 6.4 Proprietary items & Materials.</i>	<p>Alternative products do not require the Engineers approval during the bidding process.</p> <p>It is the Respondents responsibility when submitting a Conforming Tender to ensure any alternative product(s) meet the performance standards of the product specified in the RFT. Such alternatives shall not form part of the Contract until approval to the alternative is given by the Engineer.</p> <p>Products that alter the design or standards specified in the RFT can be submitted as an Alternative Tender.</p>
